The remaining asbestos materials in Community R-VI School District are detailed below:

- These materials can remain in the buildings because they are non-friable, which means they will not deteriorate.
- These materials are in good condition and cause no threat to public health.
- These materials will be inspected every six months to see that they remain in good condition.
- The entire Management Plan for Asbestos of Community R-VI School District is available to anyone, in the Superintendent's Office.
- Amounts of asbestos materials remaining:
 - High School – ≈250 square feet of boiler jacket and flue in boiler room
≈18,500 square feet of 12"x12" floor tile and mastic
 - Elementary School – ≈34,500 square feet of 12"x12" floor tile and mastic
