## Board of Education Meeting Minutes Regular Session August 17, 2010

The Community R-VI Board of Education met in Regular Session on Tuesday, August 17, 2010. Andrew Fairchild, Board President, called the meeting to order at 7:20 p.m.

The Board voted to approve the agenda. The Board approved the July 21, 2010 regular session meeting minutes. The Board approved the transfer from the general fund to the teacher's fund to cover monthly expenditures. The Board voted to set the tuition for the 2010-2011 school year at \$6,117 per student.

The Board approved payment of the August 2010 bills.

There were no presentations. Andrew Fairchild read a thank you note from Alan and Karen Stone for the stepping stone that was sent at the time of his father's death.

There were no citizen comments. There was no old business.

The Board voted to eliminate the voluntary reduction to the tax rate due to an anticipated reduction in state revenue and budgetary constraints. The Board voted to set the 2010-2011 operating levy at \$3.8400 and the debt service levy at \$0.55, for a total tax levy of \$4.3900.

Arlen Provancha, Superintendent, reported on the fire alarm installation, Board and staff dinner, and first day of school preparations. He gave an update on the asphalt and flagpole projects. He gave updates on staff and an approximation on enrollment numbers. Mr. Provancha gave an update on the security light system, district handbook and calendar, and the A+ program.

Natalie Gibson, Elementary Principal, presented the elementary school handbook. The Board voted to approve the elementary school handbook as presented. Mrs. Gibson stated the elementary school will have a western theme. She gave an update on the meet and greet and the elementary Missouri Assessment Program (MAP) scores. She reported 48 students earned Cardinal tickets.

Dale Marshall, Secondary Principal, presented the secondary school handbook. The Board voted to approve the secondary school handbook as presented. Mr. Marshall also presented the 2010-2011 athletic schedule. He discussed the Future Farmers of America (FFA) program and the National FFA Convention. Mr. Marshall gave an update on the secondary MAP scores. He stated 108 students earned Cardinal tickets. The Board voted to adjourn the meeting at 8:50 p.m.
