Board of Education Meeting Update October 19, 2010

Andrew Fairchild, Board President, called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. in the District Library. The Board voted to approve the proposed meeting agenda. The Board approved the September 21, 2010 Regular Session and the October 6, 2010 Special Meeting minutes; the transfer from the general fund to the teacher's fund to cover monthly expenditures; the September/October nurse's report; and the addition of Erin Harby and Glen Swarhout to the 2010-2011 district substitute teacher list. The Board reviewed and approved the following District Evaluations: Assessment, Curriculum, and Public Relations. The Board voted to approve the October 2010 bills.

Barbara Swaim, head cook, presented information regarding the meeting with Susan Kidwell, a Kohl Wholesale dietician. Patricia Pazdera and Nicole Poindexter, Positive Behavior Intervention Supports (PBIS) co-coaches, presented PBIS information. Rhonda Curtis commended Carylle Ann Folta on her bus preparations and cleanliness for away games. There were no citizen comments.

The Board voted to accept the revised 2010-2011 budget. The Board voted to adopt the following policies and regulations: Policy 2610, 2651, 2655, 2670, 2673, 2720, 2870, 4640, and Regulation 2662, 2870, 3380. Cheryl Snyder, transportation director, presented the 2010-2011 bus routes. The Board voted to accept the 2010-2011 bus routes.

The following staff members were randomly selected to be on the Superintendent Interview Committee: Vicki Briggs, Darla Deimeke, Eva Eikel, Sandy Gastler, Julene Littler, Melanie Utterback, Rose Wilburn, and Bonnie Wilson.

Arlen Provancha, Superintendent, gave the transportation miles and October ridership. Natalie Gibson, elementary principal, reviewed the elementary attendance report and a revised grade card format for kindergarten and first grade. Mrs. Gibson announced the PBIS assembly will be held on October 29 at 1:00 p.m. in the new gym.

Dale Marshall, secondary principal, reviewed the secondary attendance, credit recovery, tardy, and In-School Suspension (ISS) reports. He gave an update on the Future Farmers of America (FFA) program. He reviewed the plans for the cheerleading program, which will be a pep squad. The pep squad will attend all home basketball games.
